MEMORANDUM FOR All Personnel Cutting Wood on Camp Dodge Joint Maneuver Training Center (CDJMTC)

SUBJECT: CDJMTC Woodcutting Policy

1. Woodcutting privileges may be granted to the following eligible personnel:
 - a. Current or retired members of the US military, spouse, and dependents under the age of 19. The military sponsor must accompany any dependents.
 - b. Current State of Iowa Department of Public Defense full-time personnel.
2. Individuals must complete a "Release of Liability Waiver" prior to being allowed to cut wood. Liability waivers are available at CDJMTC Range Operations located at building 2196, Monday-Friday during normal duty hours (0800-1630).
3. Personnel must check in/out with Range Operations. Range Operations will issue a vehicle (POV) pass that will be displayed in the vehicle window. POV passes must be returned to Range Operations or to CDJMTC Security after duty hours upon exit of CDJMTC.
4. Woodcutting in the training areas is only permitted in locations designated by Range Operations. Woodcutting will not be permitted during periods of drought or high training area usage. The cutting of standing trees is not authorized.
5. Individuals must have a cell phone in their possession in case of injury to make emergency calls. Eye protection, hearing protection, long pants, gloves, and over the ankle boots must be worn while cutting wood.
6. Failure to follow this policy or direction from Range Operations will result in the loss of woodcutting privileges.
