

# IOWA NG 20 YEAR RING

**HISTORY** – 1967 the Iowa National Guard had started awarding the 25 Year Ring. These awards are finger rings designed to recognize service in the Iowa National Guard. The 25 Year Ring was given in addition to the silver oak leaf cluster to the Iowa National Guard State Service Ribbon and was optional. The 20 Year Ring was made available 1 July 1995. The last date to order a 25 Year Ring was 30 June 2000. Individuals were not allowed to receive both.

**ELIGIBILITY** – Twenty years of credible service in the Iowa Army and/or Air National Guard.

**REGULATION** – INGR 600-8-22, paragraph 5-1
