SUBJECT: Iowa National Guard Service Scholarship for Academic Year 22-23

1. References:

- 2. Purpose: This memorandum summarizes policy for the requirements for qualification and execution of the Iowa National Guard Service Scholarship for the Iowa National Guard and sets the award rate for the academic year.
- 3. The maximum award per SM for fall and spring semester of academic year (AY) 22-23 will not exceed **100%** of the regent's resident tuition rate or **100%** percent of the billed tuition rate at the institution attended by the SM, whichever is lower. The State Board of Regents has set resident undergraduate tuition rates for AY 22-23 at Regents institutions (reference e). I have set the maximum award for fall and spring semester of AY 22-23 at **\$5.061/semester**: **\$10.122/year**.
- 4. Eligible Service Members must meet all the following:
- a. Be a resident of lowa, attend an Iowa-based education institution, and a traditional M-day Service Member (SM) of the Iowa National Guard. Title 5 Federal Technicians who are IANG SMs are eligible to receive the INGSS and are considered M-day applicants.
 - b. Has satisfactorily completed Initial Entry Training (IET) of the SM's service.
- c. Must be in good standing at deadline (not flagged, has satisfactory drill and AT attendance, passing record physical fitness test APFT / ACFT / PFT, passing height/weight requirements) and maintain good standing throughout the term of the scholarship.
- d. Has not utilized 120 semester hours of assistance or earned a bachelor's degree or equivalent. If SM is enrolled in a STEM program that qualifies for assistance under the Edith Nourse Rogers STEM Scholarship, SM may receive benefits up to 130 credit hours by submitting proof of enrollment from the education institute to the INGSS Program Manager. It is recommended this is done pre-emptively prior to a disapproval of benefits.
 - e. Has applied for the Iowa Financial Aid Application (IFAA) and the Free Application for

Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at https://iowacollegeaid.gov/lowaNationalGuard by the application deadline date(s), 1 July for fall and spring semester or 1 December for spring semester only, unless excepted by policy or law. No exception to policy(ETP) request will be authorized for late applications. SMs on IADT or Title 10 mobilization orders over a deadline date have 30 days from end of orders (DD 214 separation date) to complete their applications.

- f. Maintains attendance and academic progress at the educational institution.
- 5. Ineligible Service Members. SMs failing an element of eligibility will receive a disapproval email upon application review. AGRs, dual status military technicians, enlisted with ETS before end of semester, or a pending separation or IST before end of the semester are also ineligible, but are encouraged to apply. Ability to fund will be based on availability of funds and approved ETP.
- 6. Exceptions to Policy. Each service (Army and Air) will determine their ETP process and consolidate requests under the IA ARNG Education Services Office for routing. SMs who are disapproved may be eligible for an ETP. Funding is not guaranteed, so all effort must be made to meet eligibility criteria before the application suspense date. Contact the INGSS Program Manager to inquire if you are eligible for an ETP.

7. Funding:

- a. Iowa National Guard Service Scholarship is a state funded program and based on annual appropriations from the state legislature.
- b. Individual awards shall not be less than fifty percent of the regents published resident tuition rate.
- c. Iowa National Guard Service Scholarship is encouraged to be combined with Federal Tuition Assistance (<u>Armylgnited</u>), and other federally funded programs such as Federal Student Aid and <u>GI Bill</u> programs when available. Contact the Education & Incentives Branch for questions on use of these programs and their use together.
