**ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS POSITION**

**GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Not currently "Flagged from Favorable Personnel Actions" or under a "Bar to Reenlistment".
2. Eligibility of female personnel will be consistent with existing Department of Army Combat Policies.
3. Must possess and maintain a secret clearance.
4. OCONUS Deployability (if applicable).
5. Review of derogatory information.

**SUMMARY OF DUTIES:** The position of First Sergeant designates the principal senior NCO at company, battery, troop, or similar sized unit. The First Sergeant will:

- 1) Assist the commander in planning, coordinating, and supervising all activities that support the unit mission.
- 2) Advise the commander on enlisted Soldier matters to include duty assignments, promotions, and reductions, leave programs, military justice, privileges, awards, welfare and recreational activities, human relations, equal opportunity, and alcohol and drug abuse concerns.
- 3) Coordinate unit administration to include submission of required report, vehicular support, supply, and food service activities.
- 4) Provide counsel and guidance to subordinate personnel.
- 5) Assist in inspection of or conduct inspection of unit activities and facilities, observe discrepancies, and initiate corrective action.
- 6) Assist the commander in performing training related tasks.
- 7) Assist the commander with Unit Strength Maintenance.
- 8) Provide guidance and training for the APFT and Weight Control Programs, Individual and Crew Serve Weapons, and Army Warrior Tasks (AWT).

**Application Documentation**

2. Current Biographical Sketch (Template on SP)
3. Enlisted Record Brief (Selection Board) only

4. Last 3 NCOERs
5. ACFT/APFT/Weight Control History (DTMS History Report Printout)
6. MEDPROS Printout
7. Memo of Non-Flagging Actions (Must be signed by commander)
8. DA Form 7424 (Sensitive Duty Assignment Eligibility Questionnaire)
9. If CLASP ETP is needed (AGR/TECH only), G1-EPM will complete the ETP and route through HRO and NGB.

### **Application Instructions**

Documents need to be scanned as **one PDF labeled as Vacancy# Last name i.e. 24-018\_Snuffy**. Do not scan documents individually.

Applications must be received and stamped into this office no later than 1630 or close of business on the closing date of announcement. Incomplete or late packets will not be accepted.

### **Applicants are placed in the following tiers. However, all eligible applicants will be boarded. The tiers are as follows:**

- (1) Current E8s on the Best Qualified List that hold the DMOS of the vacant position as a PMOS, SMOS, AMOS.
- (2) Current E7s on the Best Qualified List that hold the DMOS of the vacant position as a PMOS, SMOS, or AMOS.
- (3) Current E7s and E8s on the Best Qualified List who are non-MOS qualified for the vacant position.
- (4) Soldiers currently not on the Best Qualified List, however on the current promotion list.
